### Koper

Koper is the main Slovenian sea port and a gate to the mainland of Central Europe. It is located on the "top" of Istria, by the Adriatic Sea. Old town centre boasts rich architecture and cultural monuments. Due to its economic development, transportation infrastructure and rich cultural events the town is one of the most developed areas in Slovenia.

Koper is situated at a latitude of 45° 32,5' North and at longitude 13° 45,5' East, with a characteristic Mediterranean climate partly influenced by the continental interior. This is Koper with its mild winters and warm and dry summers.

Koper and the neighbouring coastal cities are famous for their cuisine, wine and friendly people. Koper is 10 minutes away from the Italian and Croatian border.

### Accommodation

#### Accommodation facilities for teams:

Teams will be situated in tourist resort Adria in Ankaran – a small town near Koper (10 km away). The tourist resort is located in the centre of Ankaran right next to the sea, with its own beach. Adria is a green oasis, since numerous trees offer shade and well nurtured grass pleasant camping. Facilities at the resort include indoor and outdoor swimming pools, ten-pin bowling alley, pool tables, tennis courts, volleyball courts, water sport, mini golf, sports club, bar etc. Only 100 meters from Adria there is a bank, a post office, a pharmacy, a bus stop etc. We reserve the right to collect a 500 EUR security deposit per team which will be returned at departure to guarantee damage control.

#### Teams will be accommodated in villas, bungalows and new family chalets.

The accommodation provides en suite apartments for two, three and four persons, with wardrobes, table and chairs. Each unit has a shower, toilet and wash room. All accommodations are in the middle of a lush Mediterranean park.

#### Referees will be situated in hotel Vodišek in Koper.

#### FISU and other officials will be accommodated in hotel Convent in Ankaran.

### Laundry

A chargeable laundry service will be provided.

### "Chapel" room for teams meetings

In hotel Convent on the ground floor is a "Chapel" room which will serve as a meeting room for the teams. If a team wants to hold a meeting in a "Chapel" room, a team leader has to make a reservation one day in advance. Maximum length of using the "Chapel" room is 30 minutes per meeting.



## Meals

All meals will be provided in the Hotel Convent Restaurant in a dining room exclusive to the teams and staff. The restaurant will have flexible opening hours to meet the needs of the teams and the schedule of the competition.

Three meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) per day will be available. A variety of meals will be provided (meat dishes will not include pork meat). Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be accompanied with fresh fruits and water.

Other meals (example: snacks, light meals, additional lunch, dinner etc.) can be ordered at least one day before. These additional meals will be charged to the team. Requests regarding special diet or national eating habits (example: vegetarian meals etc.) must be announced at least one month before team arrival.

- Delegations: max 12 athletes and 5 officials (excluding referee)
- Age Limit: All competitors must be born between January 1st 1980, and December 31st 1990.
- Referees: 2500 USD penalty if a team does not provide a FIFA referee
- Competition Format: 16 male university teams, full ranking championship
- Regulations: according to FISU and FIFA rules
- Accommodation: Adria resort in Ankaran for teams, separate accommodation for referees and FISU family.
- Transportation: pick up and drop off from Trieste airport, to the competition and training venues will be ensured free of charge.



## Arrivals and Departures

Arrivals are scheduled for Saturday & Sunday (August 23 & 24, 2008), and departures on September 1, 2008. The preferred airport is the Trieste (Italy) international airport [airport code: TRS], which is the closest (65 km away). Pick-up and drop-off services from this airport will be available free of charge.

## Competition format

### First Phase of Competition

Teams will compete in groups of four in a league system, each team playing one match against each of the other teams in the same group. Three points will be awarded for a win, one point for a draw and no points for a loss. All matches in each group will be played simultaneously.

The two teams finishing 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> will progress to the second phase and compete for 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> places. The two teams finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> will progress to the second phase and compete for 9<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> places.

The ranking of each team in each group will be determined as follows:

- greater number of points obtained in all group matches

Teams with Equal Points:

- greater number of points obtained in the group matches between the teams concerned
- greater goal difference resulting from the group matches between the teams concerned
- greater number of goals scored in all group matches between the teams concerned
- greater goal difference in all group matches
- greater number of goals scored in all group matches
- fair play point system in which the number of yellow and red cards is evaluated
- result of penalty shoot-out
- drawing of lots

### Second phase of Competition

In second phase of the competition teams will play in knock-out games with Group A teams played Group D teams and Group C teams playing Group B teams.

In the event of a tie in the Knock-out games:

- If the scores are level at the end of normal playing time, no extra time will be played. Kicks from the penalty mark will determine the winning team.
- If the scores are level at the end of normal playing time in the final and the third-place match, extra time consisting of two five-minute periods of effective time will be played. If the teams are still equal after extra time, the winners will be determined by kicks from the penalty mark.



## Match discipline & Protest and Appeals

In general the following will apply:

- A red card will receive a minimum of one game suspension,
- An accumulation of two yellow cards will receive a one game suspension,
- Single yellow cards will be cancelled after the first phase of games and will not be carried forward into the second phase.

Any protests of a sport or disciplinary nature must reach the TC through the referee or match Commissioner within one (1) hour of the completion of the game.

A Head of the delegation or his deputy may file a protest against the decision of the TC. This protest must be submitted in writing to the Jury of Appeal in accordance with the regulation of the FIFA or FISU technical regulation. Such protest must be accompanied by the regulatory FISU deposit of US\$ 50, which will be returned if the protest is upheld.

All decisions of the Jury of Appeal are considered final and will be reported immediately to the Head of the delegation of country concerned.

## Awards

Awards are presented immediately after the Official Ceremony after final match (around 22.30).

The awards include the following:

- the match Referees and Timekeepers
- the match Commissioners
- the best player
- the best goalkeeper
- the top scorer
- the Fair Play award

A nominated panel of judges determines the best player and best goalkeeper. The Fair Play is awarded to a team and is determined by a formula that includes the team disciplinary records.

## Match countdown – timeline

- 100 minutes: bus departure from Adria resort reception
- 75 minutes: arrival at the hall of referees, teams and other officials of the match
- 60 minutes: starting lists to be received by Match Commissioner from the team
- 45 to 15 minutes: warm up
- 15 minutes: announcements of teams, players and referees
- 10 minutes: accreditation cards/players checked; cards remove and taken to table officials/match commissioners
- 8 minutes: opening announcement
- 5 minutes: teams come onto the pitch and stand in line facing the VIP box (introducing of players and referees)
- 3 minutes: FISU anthem followed by fair play handshakes
- 2 minutes: team photo
- 1 minutes: captain meet with referee for toss of coin
- 0 minutes: kick-off

Half-time interval: 15 minutes

After the final whistle: Both teams and referees gather in the centre circle, say goodbye to each other, wave goodbye to the spectators and leave the pitch.

For warm up each team can use up to 8 balls.

## Press – Interviews

After each match press interviews will take place in Press centre in Bonifika sports hall. Each team has to ensure one player and coach for the interview.
